

3. User must be in a course.


Features

1. The Moodle Course Page
 - The Moodle Course page composed of major sections.
 - The **Unit Code and Name** bears the Unit code with current year and term and full unit name.
 - The **Navigation bar** is the row of links you will find at the top left of your Moodle site. The navigation bar shows a user their current context path, with links to the higher contexts. The navigation bar is sometimes referred to as breadcrumbs.
 - The **Navigation block** is updated based on the content of a page. Expand it to see the various functions such as Participants, Badges, Competencies, Grades, and the course sections name.
 - The **Focus Mode** lets you shift to screen with out the header and navigation block.
 - The Course sections include 3 distinct sections such as General section, Assessment section, and Teaching Sections.
 - The **General Section** provides the unit **synopsis, key information, announcements, Unit Information Guide, Staff Contact Details** and **Timetable**.
 - The **Assessments Section** is where you find the sub-sections Assessable assessments and Unit evaluation. The sub-section Assessable assessments includes all the assessments submission links and resources. The sub-section Unit evaluation includes the link to unit and lecturer's evaluation.
 - The **Teaching Sections** are comprising various sections containing the instructions, materials and formative assessments. Each section contains the guide for to complete the section's, lessons mainly in Echo360 videos and the formative assessments.
