### Overview

Read the instruction well before you attempt any quiz. If you feel like you don't have enough information, feel free to ask your Lecturer about the quiz details.

### Pre-condition

1. The user must be on a Moodle course page as a student of the unit. See [Moodle Enrolment](#), [Accessing your course](#), and [The Moodle course](#).
2. Get enough details of the quiz you need to take from your Lecturer. Ask about the section and title.
3. You may take this [Practice quiz](#) to gain confidence before taking the actual quiz.

### A. Taking a quiz

#### Procedure

1. Accessing Quiz summary page.
  - a. Find the quiz link on your Moodle course page. An **assessable quiz** can be found in the **Assessment section**, while non-assessable quizzes can be found in the teaching sections.
  - b. Click on the Quiz name to access the Quiz summary page.
2. Examining Quiz summary
  - a. On the Quiz page, examine the summary of information about the quiz. This may include:
    - The number of questions and total marks allocated.
    - The number of times you can retake the quiz (called "attempts").
    - The date range the quiz is available to take.
    - The time limit for taking the quiz.


#### Assessment 1 Quiz 1.1 5%

3. Attempting a quiz

4. To start, click **Attempt quiz now**. A confirmation page will remind you of any time restrictions or the limited number of attempts.



**Note:** If your quiz is interrupted, you can return to the quiz and click Continue the last attempt to resume your work, even if you lose your connection to Moodle, as long as the deadline for the quiz has not passed.

5. Answering quiz questions.

- a. Read the quiz question carefully and decide on the answer. Quizzes may have one or more questions per page. The way you answer each question may vary based on the question type. Each question has a status on display.
- b. You can use the Quiz navigation panel (on the right) to move between quiz pages for multiple page quizzes. The panel will show your progress and how much time you have remaining if your instructor set a time limit for the quiz. If the Lecturer enables free navigation, you can use the Quiz navigation panel to move to another page or return to complete any unanswered questions. Completed questions will be highlighted differently from unanswered questions in the Quiz navigation panel.
- c. You will need to click **Submit** for some quiz and/or question types to ensure your answer is recorded. Enter your answers for questions without submit buttons and click **Next** (on the bottom) to continue.
- d. You may use the **Flag question** to bookmark the question. This is handy when you are not sure about the answer and decide to leave to attend to other questions. When clicked, the icon changes into a red flag.





## 6. Finishing a quiz attempt

- Before the quiz ends, ensure that you clear the Flagged questions and all the quiz items are in orange color in the *quiz navigation panel*.
- Click Finish attempt to the end of a quiz, the Summary of attempt page will open. This page lists the quiz questions and indicates which ones have been answered.
- To return to a question for review or complete an unanswered question, click the Question number.

Note: Quiz attempt may be finished by clicking the **Finish attempt...** or when your time is finish.


